

What God's word says about profane, vulgar, and perverted language.

From the fruit of his lips a man is filled with good things just as the work of his hands rewards him. ([pro. 12:14](#))

From the fruit of his mouth a man's stomach is filled; with the harvest from his lips he is satisfied. ([pro. 18:20](#))

Put away perversity from you mouth; keep corrupt talk far from your lips. ([pro. 4:24](#))

Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers. ([eph. 4:29](#))

But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; ([1 pe 1:15](#))

But your iniquities have separated between you and our God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear. For your hands are defiled with blood, and your fingers with iniquity; your lips have spoken lies, your tongue hath muttered perverseness. ([isa. 59:2,3](#))

Nor should there be obscenity, foolish talk or coarse joking, which is out of place ... ([eph 5:4](#))

May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight ... ([ps. 19:14](#))

..."I will watch my ways and keep my tongue from sin l.." ([ps. 39:1](#))

Death and life are in the power of the tongue; and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof. ([pro. 18:21](#))

To fear the Lord is to hate evil; I hate pride and arrogance, evil behavior and perverse speech. ([pro. 8:13](#))

If anyone considers himself religious [saved] and yet does not keep a tight rein on his tongue, he deceives himself and his religion is worthless. ([ja. 1:26](#))

The tongue also is a fire, a world of evil among the parts of the body. It corrupts the whole person, sets the whole course of his life on fire, and is itself set on fire by Hell. ([ja. 3:6](#))

[With the tongue] bless we God, even the Father, and therewith curse we men, which are made after the similitude of God. Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not so to be. ([ja. 3:9,10](#))

But the things that come out of the mouth come from the heart. ([mt. 15:18](#))

For out of the overflow of the heart the mouth speaks. the good man brings good things out of the good stored up in him. and the evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in him.

But I tell you that men will have to give account on the day of judgement for every careless word they have spoken. For by your words you will be acquitted, and by your words you will be condemned. ([mt. 12:34-37](#))

Friends, in spite of the social acceptance of such language, God's word still considers it unfit for usage, especially by those of us who call on His son as our Lord and Savior. As you can see from some of the scriptures above, using undefiled language has its rewards. Unfortunately, using unfit language has its rewards as well, although you might not want it.

With that in mind, usage of unfit language may just be the very thing that is coming between you and your success. Don't let such words take up residence in your heart, they will eventually be expelled from your mouth. Think about it. It should be clear that profanity is not of God because you would not use such language in church, and as such is actually rebellion against God's word. This means it is rebellion against God himself. I remind you that rebellion against God is the spirit of witchcraft.
